CAGELCO II DEPLOYS TASKFORCE TO ASSIST ECS SEVERELY HIT BY ST “UWAN”

Cagayan II Electric Cooperative, Inc. deployed Task Force-Kapatid Teams to three Electric Cooperatives in Nueva Vizcaya, Isabela and Quirino on November, 2025 to aid in power restoration efforts after Super Typhoon “Uwan” caused widespread power interruptions in the region.

The first CAGELCO II team was dispatched on November 12 to assist Nueva Vizcaya Electric Cooperative (NUVELCO), followed by another deployment on November 14 to Isabela I Electric Cooperative, Inc. (ISELCO I). A third contingent was sent on November 20 to support Quirino Electric Cooperative (QUIRELCO) where widespread outages affected numerous consumers.

CAGELCO II's Task Force-Kapatid was composed of Linemen Jammysol Tibuc (Team Leader), Jarvis Bernardo

(Team Leader), Jose Maria Cardenas, Jerome Rambuyon, Dominic Agoto, Brevidier Bunuen, and Raymond Paa who worked alongside other Task Force Kapatid Teams from neighboring Electric Cooperatives, repairing damaged distribution lines and restoring electricity in heavily affected communities.

Taskforce Kapatid is organized through the National Electrification Administration (NEA), Philippine Rural Electric Cooperatives Association (PHILRECA), in partnership with the 1-

EC Network Foundation and Electric Cooperatives nationwide.

This initiative mobilizes personnel and equipment to ensure faster power restoration in areas impacted by natural disasters and other major disruptions.

Through this assistance, CAGELCO II reaffirmed its commitment to solidarity and service, underscoring the cooperative spirit among electric cooperatives in times of crisis.

CHARGED FOR SUCCESS: CAGELCO II LTC GRADUATES SHINE BRIGHT

After a month-long rigorous training, 35 gentlemen successfully completed the CAGELCO II Line Workers' Training Course (LTC) which equipped them with essential technical skills and knowledge required to perform the demanding duties of a professional Line Worker.

The program which started in October 6, 2025 covered lectures on specifications and drawings for Distribution Line Construction and Pole exercises which included mastery in Pole Climbing, Material Identification, Insulator Tying, Conductor riding and Knot-tying led by CAGELCO II's Master Trainer Engr. Elmer P. Francisco and Assistant Trainer Engr. Efren P. Lorecha.

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The graduates were also equipped with basic competencies and knowledge on the Electric Power Industry and Electric Cooperative operations. Likewise, they were educated on the importance of team building and fostering a respectful workplace, occupational safety and health including lectures on Computer operations, Networking and Fiber Optic Maintenance delivered by CAGELCO II employees- ISD Manager Kristine T. Basquez, Chief HRDA Odessa Mae A. Guillano, HR Officer Glorina M. Pagaduan, Area Manager Engr. Nathaniel L. Reyes, and MIS Head Leonard A. Sandoval.

Meanwhile, part of the core competencies covered lectures with actual application on Secondary Lines, Distribution Transformers, Service Dropping and kilowatt-hour meters which were discussed by CAGELCO II Special Equipment Section Head Engr. Paul Christian Olangco, while Electrical Safety and Staking Sheet Reading were presented by CAGELCO II Transmission and Substation Division Chief Engr. Algeron R. Orquia and Engineering Division Chief Engr. Darwin R. Guimay, respectively.

POWER RATES SA 4TH QUARTER NG 2025

Sa huling kwarter ng 2025, nakapagtala ang CAGELCO II ng paggalaw sa singil ng kuryente - mula sa pagbaba sa buwan ng Oktubre, na sinundan ng pagtaas sa Nobyembre, hanggang sa muling pagbaba ng power rate sa katapusan ng taon.

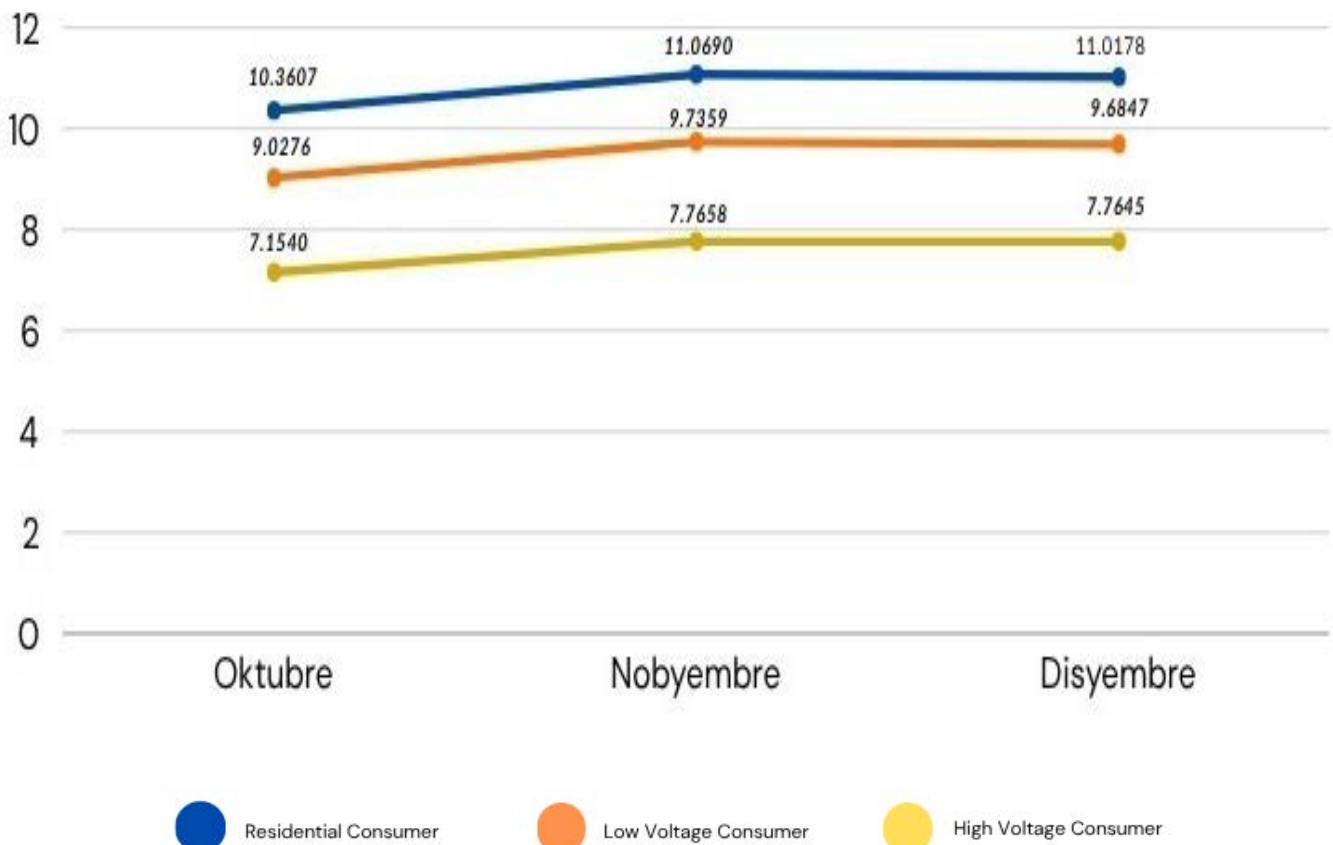
Para sa Residential Consumers, bumaba sa Php 10.3607 kada kWh ang power rate sa buwan ng Oktubre dahil sa pagbaba ng singil ng Generation Charge mula sa power suppliers bunsod ng pagkakaroon ng sapat na suplay ng kuryente at mababang demand mula sa mga consumers.

Sa pagdating naman ng buwan ng Nobyembre ay tumaas ito sa Php 11.0690 kada kWh dahil sa

pagtaas ng Generation Charge at pati na rin ng Transmission charge na napupunta sa National Grid Corporation of the Philippines. Nakaapekto rin dito ang pagtaas ng Feed-in Tariff Allowance (FIT-ALL) Charge na sinisingil sa lahat ng consumers bilang pagsuporta sa pagpapaunlad ng renewable energy sources sa bansa na inire-remit sa National Transmission Corporation (TRANSCO).

Sa buwan naman ng Disyembre, nakaapekto ang pagbaba ng transmission charge mula sa NGCP kung saan umabot sa halagang Php 11.0178 kada kWh ang CAGELCO II power rate.

Samantala, nananatiling hindi nagbabago ang Distribution, Supply, at Metering (DSM) Charges na direktang napupunta sa CAGELCO II sa halagang Php 2.4034 kada kWh.
